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The following assistance is requested from the parents of children who are participating in sports activities. Cooperation will allow for control of players and fans and assist the coaches in managing a successful sports program.

1. Parents/guardians are required to provide an up to date sports physical for the student prior to participation in a sports activity. The sports participation fee must be paid before a student can participate. Each sports activity has a different associated fee.
2. Parents are required to notify coaches of any medical conditions that may affect their child, as well as provide and administer any needed medications. Coaches may not administer medications.
3. Parents should provide transportation to and from games and practices or make arrangements for it. Our coaches are volunteers and have other commitments. Please be prompt and follow the timelines for practices, games and events for arrival and pick-up. Please be mindful that coaches may not include siblings who are not registered for the specific activity and will not allow the sibling to remain.
4. Parents are expected to supervise their other children who may be attending practices, games or meets as spectators. These children should remain in the stands or fan area and not be allowed to wander around fields or gymnasiums.
5. Parents will be asked to volunteer in the snack shack and at other tournaments and events that support the sports program of our school. Please volunteer.
6. Team uniforms (if required) must be purchased by the family prior to the start of the sports activity. Wearing the uniform is an honor. The student athlete represents the school. Team uniforms should only be worn for games and events as required by coaches and the school.
7. Parents/guardians must review the Sports Handbook for the Unified Schools of St. Mary Magdalen & St. John the Evangelist and complete the signature page. This signature page is an annual form and once signed it remains in place for the academic year.
8. The spirit of the sports program of the Unified Schools of St. Mary Magdalen & St. John the Evangelist is for children to learn, be competitive and to enjoy sports in a Christian atmosphere. Your help in this goal is of the utmost importance.
